"...A vivid purple in the glass. The nose offers dark fruit and hints of mountain herbs alongside a whiff of cigar box. Intense and free flowing with a good but refined tannin structure that enhances the volume, it delivers plenty of juice. The warm year ensured a fruity profile overall."

"...Dark purple in hue, the aromas feature fresh plum, violets and country herbs with hints of vanilla and pencil box. Juicy and free-flowing with good, intense flavor, the tannins are gentle and rounded but enhanced by the precise freshness. The finish is long and fruity."

"A Malbec from Los Chacayes, Uco Valley, 60% aged in new and used barrels for 10 months. Bright violet with a ripe profile. The nose offer notes of blackberry, plum and camphor with herbal hints and a cedar bed. Sensuous in the mouth, the tannins have grip while the juiciness is down to the refreshing acidity and an extractive quality that empowers the tannings. Accomplished for the style."
