2022

• 91 Pts. – JAMES SUCKLING, July 2024

"Sweet strawberries, violets and a touch of tobacco on the nose, followed by surprisingly firm tannins on the medium- to full-bodied palate. Try from 2025."

2020

• 91 Pts. – JAMES SUCKLING, December 14, 2021

"This is a tannic Morgon with lots of chewiness. Blackberry and cherry character with lemon zest undertones. It's full and layered with a fresh, juicy finish. Drink or hold."

2019

• 91 Pts. - JAMES SUCKLING, April 23, 2021

"Lots of ripe strawberry and raspberry on the nose with lemon zest, red tea and freshly turned soil. It's medium-bodied with tight, fine-grained tannins. Focused and reserved with a mineral finish."

2018

• 92 Pts. - JAMES SUCKLING, February 20, 2020

"Lots of lifted and ripe fruit on the nose, such as raspberries and dried strawberries that follow through to a medium to full body, fine tannins and a savory finish."

2017

• 92 Pts. – JAMES SUCKLING, December 21, 2018

"Intense aromas of dried apricots and dark berries. Hints of dried mushrooms too. Full bodied yet linear with good drive through the center palate. Serious. Drink or hold."

• 90 Pts. - WINE & SPIRITS, April 2019

"This is a lively Morgon with dark currant and sweet cherry flavors layered over earthbound tannins. The tannins tighten up the fruit and ground it, keeping it savory in the end. Serve this cellar temperature with roast quail or other game."

2016

• 90 Pts. – JAMES SUCKLING, February 22, 2018

"A very direct array of blueberries, cassis and blackberries. There is also a very strong emphasis on the fruit. Quite round. Raspberries on the palate."

2015

• 93 Pts. – JAMES SUCKLING, February 11, 2017

"Wow. Wonderful nose here of crushed blackberries, blueberries and orange peel follows through to a medium to full body, firm and silky tannins and a long and flavorful finish. Linear and polished with a very pretty mouthfeel. Drink or hold."
