• 92 - JAMES SUCKLING, September 18, 2024

"Leathery nose with some earthy, dusty berries, sous-bois and mint. Still plenty of fruit, with savory plums and cherries. Medium to full body on the palate with dusty tannins and a fluid, elegant finish. A warmer vintage, but still fresh and composed. Long and juicy. Drink now."

2014

• 93 – JAMES SUCKLING, May 27, 2022

"Complex and ethereal dark plums, savory spices and tobacco with sweet spices, iron and dried orange peel. This is long and elegant on the palate, rounded by creamy and firm tannins. Drink or hold."

2012

• 92 - JAMES SUCKLING, March 23, 2022

"Intense aromas of figs, dried cherries, toasted coconut, caramel, mushrooms and sweet herbs. It's medium-bodied with firm, sleek tannins and fresh acidity. Rich array of spice and dried fruit, with persistent freshness. Drink or hold."

2011

• 92 – JAMES SUCKLING, September 15, 2020

A savory, earthy red with plum, tobacco, shitake-mushroom and walnut character. Medium body with a firm, silky tannined palate and a persistent finish. Lean, but fresh. Drink Now."

• 93 - JAMES SUCKLING, July 5, 2019

"Lots of subtle fruit character to this wine from an excellent vintage and now showing age. Medium to full body. Fine tannins and a flavorful finish. Drink now.

• 92 – WINE ENTHUSIAST

"Ripe berry, prune and raisin aromas are at the core of a nose that's also driven by coconut and vanilla accents. A rustic mouthfeel with grippy tannins frames savory, oaky red berry and plum flavors, while tobacco and vanilla notes are corralled by a drying finish. Drink through 2028."
